These intellectual property (IP) can be used by the creator themselves or can be assigned or licensed to others. Herein comes into picture the legal aspects of these important IP. If the legal protection is not granted counterfeiting or unauthorized use of these IP would be rampant. This unauthorized use will act as an impediment to further innovations and this in turn will affect the growth and development of the economic sector. Hence management of these IP is the need of the hour. There is a need to create awareness about the role played by IP in the development of an economy. Awareness regarding the various procedural aspects pertaining as to the legal protection of the IP is essential.
